

Subject: Approval of Resolution Authorizing and Approving Financing through Lease

Purchase and Award of Lease Purchase Contract – Replacement Sanitation Truck,

as Approved by Council on September 6, 2022

Issue

Approval of a Resolution authorizing and approving financing through a Lease/Purchase and awarding of the Lease/Purchase Contract to a Financial Institution for One (1) Replacement Sanitation truck.

Discussion

The replacement Sanitation truck was approved for purchase by Council on September 6, 2022. The total value and thus financing will not exceed \$250,000. Staff contacted 18 financial institutions and requested lease purchase financing proposals for the Sanitation truck based on the purchase price. Due to the rising interest rate environment, staff requested the financial institutions to propose both a 36-month term and 48-month term. The City received two (2) responses:

Truist Financial: Three (3) years at 3.99%

Four (4) years at 4.05%

U.S. Bankcorp: Three (3) years at 4.61%

Four (4) years at 4.63%

If the City of Cayce approves the Truist Financial 48-month lease, annual payments (with no down payment) would be as follows:

\$67,805 annually for 4 Years at 4.05% (total interest paid \$21,217.28)

The payments shall be monthly in arrears. As this is an unbudgeted purchase, staff proposes using General Fund's unrestricted fund balance for the current year lease payment (estimated at \$45,202.88, including principal and interest, assuming a payment start date of November). Successive years' funding for the lease/purchase contract will be included in the General Fund budget under Non-Departmental expense with the other leases.

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the lease-purchase contract be awarded to Truist Financial for a four (4) year term contract at 4.05% with annual payments in arrears of \$67,805 for principal and interest, using the General Fund unrestricted fund balance to fund the current year lease payment with a not to exceed amount of \$46,000.00. Staff also recommends that Council approve a "Resolution Approving Financing" through Truist Financial and that the City Manager be authorized to execute the contract documents.

WHEREAS, the City of Cayce ("City") has previously determined to undertake a project for the financing of one (1) Replacement Sanitation Truck for The General Fund Lease Purchase ("the Project"), and the Finance Officer has now presented a proposal for the financing of such Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the City of Cayce, in Council, duly assembled, that:

- 1. The City hereby determines to finance the Project through Truist Financial, in accordance with the proposal dated October 4, 2022. The amount financed shall not exceed \$250,000, the annual interest rate (in the absence of default or change in tax status) shall not exceed 4.05%, and the term shall not exceed four (4) years.
- 2. All financing contracts and all related documents for the closing of the financing (the "Financial Documents") shall be consistent with the foregoing terms. All officers and employees of the City are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver any Financing Documents, and to take all such further action as they may consider necessary or desirable, to carry out the financing of the Project as contemplated by the proposal and this resolution. The Financing Documents shall include a Financing Agreement and an Escrow Agreement as Truist Financial may request.
- 3. The Finance Officer is hereby authorized and directed to hold executed copies of the Financing Documents until the conditions for the delivery of the Financing Documents have been completed to such officer's satisfaction. The Financing Officer is authorized to approve changes to any Financing Documents previously signed by City officers or employees, provided that such changes shall not substantially alter the intent of such documents or certificates from the intent expressed in the forms executed by such officers. The Financing Documents shall be in such final forms as the Finance Officer shall approve, with the Finance Officer's release of any Financing Document for delivery constituting conclusive evidence of such officer's final approval of the Document's final form.
- 4. The City shall not take or omit to take any action the taking or omission of which shall cause its interest payments on this financing to be

includable in the gross income for federal income tax purposes of the registered owners of the interest payment obligations. The City hereby designates its obligations to make principal and interest payments under the Financing Documents as "qualified tax-exempt obligations" for the purpose of Internal Revenue Code Section 265 (b)(3).

- 5. The City intends that the adoption of this resolution will be a declaration of the City's official intent to reimburse expenditures for the project that is to be financed from the proceeds of the Truist Financial financing described above. The City intends that funds that have been advanced, or that may be advanced, from the City's general fund or any other City fund related to the project, for project costs may be reimbursed from the financing proceeds.
- 6. All prior actions of City officers in furtherance of the purposes of this resolution are hereby ratified, approved and confirmed. All other resolutions (or parts thereof) in conflict with this resolution are hereby repealed, to the extent of the conflict. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

Subject: Replacement of Police Vehicle

ISSUE

Council approval is needed for the purchase of one Chevrolet Tahoe to replace a vehicle that was involved in a collision and determined to be a total loss.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

The Police Department had a 2019 Ford Interceptor, with 41,600 miles (vehicle #122), involved in a collision that the insurance company determined to be a total loss. The insurance company is issuing a check to the City for \$23,000 and will be deposited in revenues as the sale of City property.

The total cost to replace the vehicle is \$47,844.75. Staff requests utilizing funds from the General Fund unrestricted fund balance for this unexpected and unbudgeted purchase. The General Fund will be replenished with the revenue recovered from insurance and other property sales, estimated to total \$47,844.75 for this fiscal year. The vehicle is currently available at Brannon Motor Company in Georgia and is on a State contract.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends Council approve the purchase of one police package Tahoe to replace vehicle #122 in the amount of \$47,844.75 from the General Fund unrestricted fund balance.
